

Rules and Information

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret any and all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management, their decisions to be final.

Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit the exhibition of entries, and cancel cash prizes without claim for damages; to change any course, cancel or combine any classes, or to make changes management deems to be in the best interest of the show. Every horse entered for the competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the show, its members, directors and employees, facility and Four Reel Farm LLC harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, injury, fire, or otherwise.

AWARDS - Ribbons 1st-6th in all classes, special award for 1st Place. Daily high point champions awarded in all divisions.

YEAR-END HIGH POINT CHAMPIONS to be Awarded in 14 Divisions at the December Show. Special Ribbons and prizes through sixth place.

Same Horse/Rider combination must have shown in 3 or more shows in the same Division to be eligible for year end. Horse/Pony name must be the same throughout year for points to count.

ATTIRE/EQUIPMENT - proper basic show attire for the rider is encouraged, includes boots/ jodhpur boots with 1/2" heel (required) collared shirts-no tank tops. Hunt coats optional. USEF rules will apply for equipment for the horse. An ASTM approved helmet is required, harness attached and fastened, for all exhibitors while mounted. Martingales are prohibited in all under saddle classes. Any questions concerning tack will be at the sole discretion of the judge and/or show management, their decision to be final.

SCHOOLING - Paid Open Schooling available on Friday from 12:00-5:00 p.m., \$30/Entered horses; \$55 non showing.

Entry/ Release Form Must be signed before schooling.

Arenas open for schooling on show mornings from 7 am until 1/2 hour before the start of 1st class at no charge.

RETURNED CHECKS- Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a 10% penalty (minimum of \$25)

STALLIONS may be ridden, handled, and shown by adult riders 18 years of age and older. Minors may not show, ride or handle a stallion at any FRF show, no exceptions.

ALCOHOL- the consumption or possessions of alcohol is not allowed on show grounds during any Four Reel Farm show

Haul-In: \$25 per Horse

Office Fee: \$25 per Entry (may not be split)

Day Stall: \$60 please specify which day needed

Overnight Stall: \$75 per Fri-Sat / Sat-Sun please specify

Weekend Stal: \$85 (Fri-Sun)

Stalls include 1 Bag of Shavings per stall

Stall Deposit: \$25 per Stall & must be received with Entry

Shavings: \$13.50 per Bag

- Each entry must pay either for a Stall or Haul-In Fee, not both
- Additional shavings available at Facility pricing. Please pre order. No outside bedding allowed per Facility rules.
- Stalls are limited and will be assigned on a first come basis.
- A complete filled out entry form, including classes entered, along with the \$25 non-refundable deposit must be received by Pre entry deadline to hold a stall. If entry & payment are received by deadline, the \$25 will be applied to your final show bill.
